Year 5 had a great time at Perlethorpe as part of their WW2 evacuee day last week. We took part in an orienteering activity, where we had to identify planes. We also enjoyed being in the old school room and finding out which families we would be sent to live with. We were definitely glad we got to come home!



KS2 (Years 3 and 4) This half term the vehicle for Y3 is the battle of the

mines and last week the three classes visited Pleasley Pit. The children spoke to some ex-miners who are now volunteers at the mine to lean about what life was like down the mine but also understand how mines work. The children saw the engines and the headstocks which lowered the miners into the mine, and the children got a chance to stand inside the lift that miners for 100 years went down into the pit. The children saw old machinery and equipment and got a talk on how they used to mine coal starting with a pickaxe through to blowing coal up with dynamite. The Y3 Children completed fieldwork on human and physical geography whilst exploring the country park around the pit.
