
<u>EYFS</u>

This week the children came back to school and were so excited to see a castle in our classroom! Year 1 have been looking at Me, Myself and I in last half term's vehicle. As part of this they read When I was Little by Jamie Lee Curtis and were asked to become author's and create lift the flap books by a publisher.

They created a page for a class book looking at their memoirs by comparing toys they played with when they were little to the toys they play with now. These were sent to the publisher who chose their favourite from each class and sent them a book.



KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

What do poppies represent?


