## EYFS

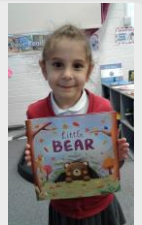

## KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

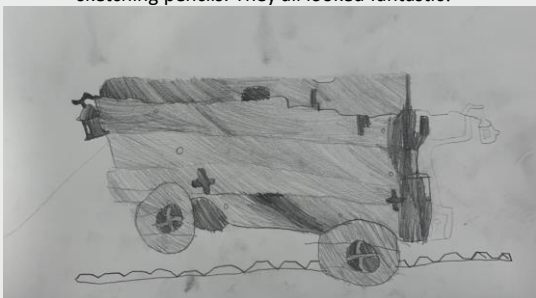

## KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Year 3 have been sketching minecarts this week. We had to look carefully at the darker and lighter parts of the minecart as our focus was to add tone to our sketches by adjusting pressure and using different sketching pencils. They all looked fantastic!



## KS2 (Years 5 and 6)

This week in year 5 we have been researching ways to help combat deforestation and have used our findings to inform a letter to put to Boris Johnson as part of the COP26 Climate Change Summit. We have discussed these world issues in our RE lesson and how, after exploring the story Genesis, Christians may feel about these current world issues.



### Look out for:

The children in Year 1 have had lots of fun this week using their fine motor skills to carve their own pumpkin faces. We have had to learn how to cut, carve and scoop to be able to do this which was quite tricky and took a lot of concentration. We have also been practicing our smudging techniques by drawing with chalk some unusual pumpkins. We learnt to look carefully at the colours of the pumpkins, draw the outlines and then smudge the chalk to blend the colours together. We didn't realise how many different shaped/coloured pumpkins there were!
