This week, we would like to celebrate Marcus Rashford. Marcus is a well-known footballer. On the 9<sup>th</sup> November, he received an MBE from Prince William which he dedicated to his mum. Marcus was awarded this because he helped to feed children across the country during lockdown. He is also the youngest person to ever receive and honorary doctorate from the University of Manchester for his work with fighting child poverty. Did you know that Marcus began his football career at the age of 5? He started out playing as a goalkeeper and by the time he was seven, he joined the Manchester United Academy system. Who is their favorite storybook character and why they like them?


Imagine your favourite character came to life and you had to interview them.
