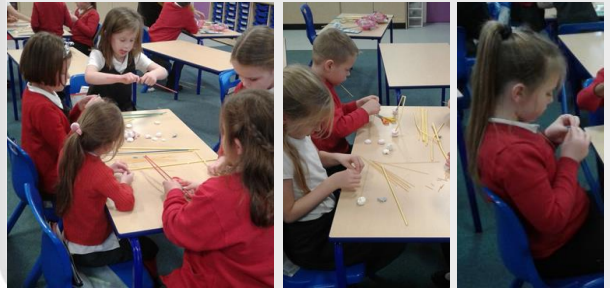
Don't forget!

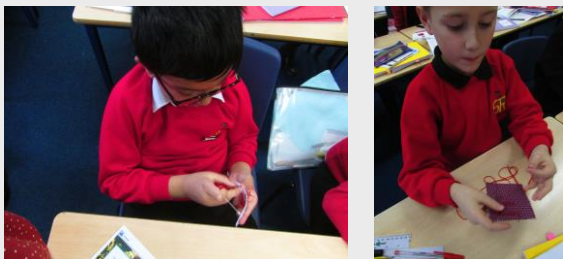
KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Year 6 residential - we have organised a 3-day visit to Walesby Forest Outdoor Activity Centre (near Newark). This will give pupils the opportunity to take part in a number of outdoor adventurous activities including raft building, zip-wire, climbing, archery, abseiling and kayaking. During the visit, the pupils will stay in two lodges on the site.

The visit is booked for Monday 20th June –Wednesday 22nd June 2021 and will include overnight accommodation, food and transport. The cost of the visit is currently approximately £170 per child (although this will depend on the number of children who choose to attend). However, as a school we intend to carry out fundraising events to support towards the cost and are also looking into funding available to support with this. We will also be able to set up payment cards to support with the cost of this over the coming months.
