Could we please ask that you send in a white top in a bag (named please) for **Wednesday 9th December** – a school polo top is also fine.



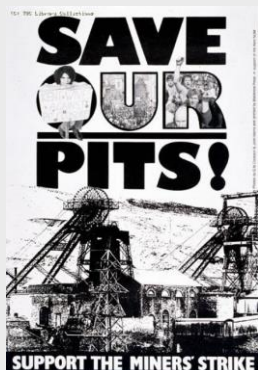
KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Where is your story set?

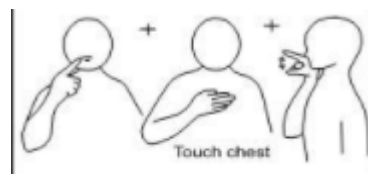
What will happen to the character in the story?
