Can we please remind all parents to make sure children's names are in their jumpers, cardigans coats, hats and scarves etc. As we do have a lot of items in our lost property without names.

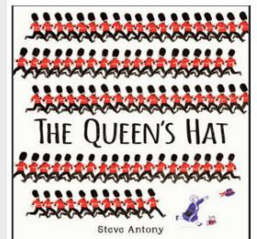

For this weeks' time to talk we would like you to create a Storytelling Prompts Jar  
 Grab an empty jar from your kitchen and some torn up pieces of paper. On each small piece of paper write a random word or phrase. This could be anything, such as cat, princess or a phrase. Put all the torn-up pieces of paper inside the jar. Then take turns to take out a piece of paper. Whatever the word is on that paper, that person must tell a story using that word or phrase. If your child gets stuck, you can use prompts, such as:  
 "What does your character see or hear?"  
 "Who else is there?"  
 "What does the place look like?"  
 "What is happening to you character?"
