


Week beginning – 3.1.2022

KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

This may look like a pile of old boxes but its not!! This is the beginning of the year 2 Tudor houses. The children have found out about how Tudor houses were built and have learnt the words Wattle and Daub, Wooden beams, Jetty.

They know that the ground floor was built smaller than the first fall and some houses had a third floor that was bigger than the second floor. They are working in groups to create the Tudor houses. Time 2 Chat:


For this week's time to talk we would like you to get those old family photos out and tell some memorable stories!
