What would they do if they were King or Queen?

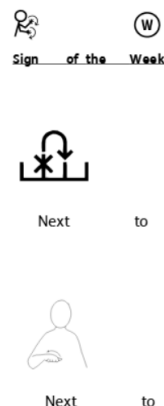
