KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

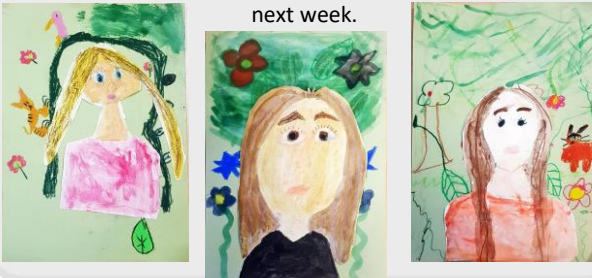

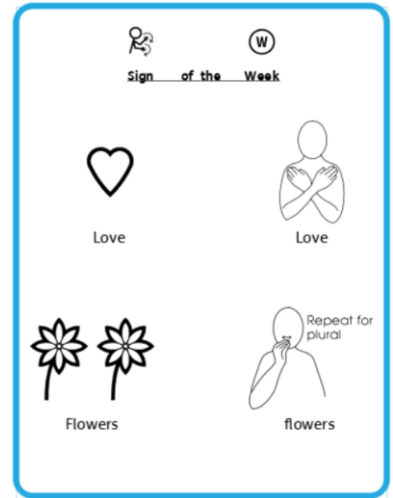
