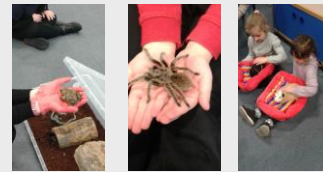
Here are some photos of our new nursery play equipment.

A big thank you to Parents group who have made this possible.



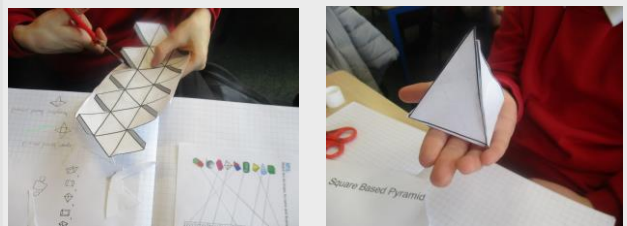
KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

This week we would like you to play a little game to get talking. You can turn the game in to a competition if you like by using a timer and keeping a score of each other's answers.

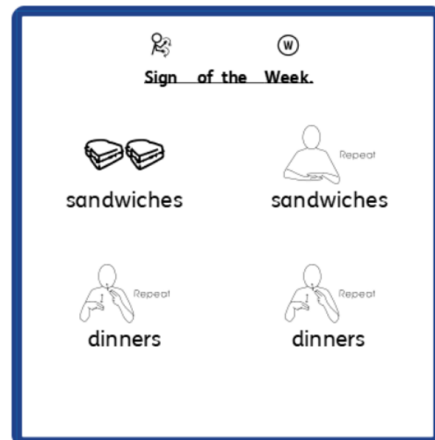
Write down a series of questions (some ideas below) take it in turns to pick a question and answer it. Perhaps give a point for each answer and count up to see who is the winner
