KS1 (Years 1 and 2)

Year 1 were visited by The Dogs Trust as part of their Fur, Feathers and Scales vehicle. They learnt the 5 rules to be Dog Smart.

- 1. If a dog is sleeping, leave it alone
- 2. If a dog is eating, leave it alone.
- 3. A dog does not like hugs it likes gentle stroking(stoke dogs on their backs) 4. A dog hears 4 x louder than we do so we need to be quite around them.
 - 5. Do not take anything out of a dog's mouth, tell a grown up.

They learnt that they need to ask an owner to stroke their dog but to let the dog sniff them and choose if it wants to be stroked. They also learnt to stand still, hug themselves and look away from a dog if they did not want dogs to come to them.

Joint highest classes this week are 6HM and 3EB with 97%


Time 2 Chat:
