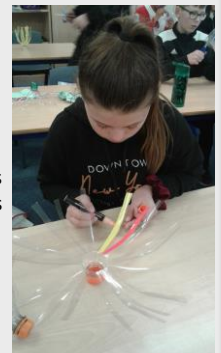
KS2 (Years 3 and 4)

Why did they do.....in the story?

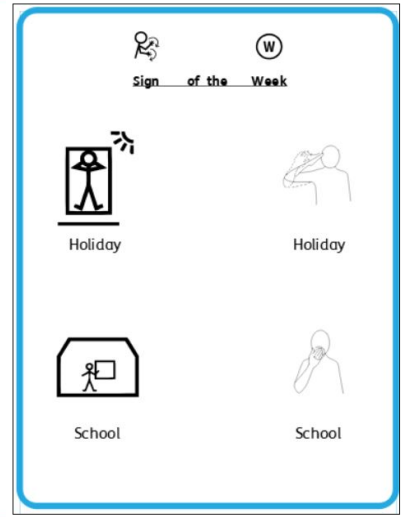
Who is their best friend?
